

PAN-AMERICAN GOLF ASSOCIATION OF DALLAS SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Dallas Pan American Golf Association was organized in 1953 and consists of more than 70 members in Dallas and the surrounding communities. In addition to promoting golf, the association traditionally awards scholarships to worthy students. The monies from this scholarship will be given over to each student and must be used for school tuition, books or student fees.

TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP, YOU MUST:

- 1. Be a high school graduate
- 2. Graduate on the upper half of your graduating class
- 3. Establish financial need
- 4. Enroll in a program which leads to the awarding of a certificate (vocational/technical program, an associate degree, bachelor's degree, master's degree or doctor's degree)
- 5. Enroll or currently enrolled in a vocational trade school, community college or four-year college or university
- 6. Submit the following postmarked no later than November 10th of 2024.
 - A. A properly completed application form (a detailed answer is preferable)
 - B. Your latest transcript
 - C. A letter of recommendation from a Dallas Pan American Golf Association member in good standing. The Dallas PAGA member must be related to the applicant. Example: son, daughter, granddaughter, grandson, nephew, niece etc.
